

Lesson Four

Ezekiel Chapters 12, 13, 14, 15

Chapter 12

1. Twice in verse one God told Ezekiel that he was living in the midst of a “rebellious house”. What specifically was wrong with their “eyes” and their “ears”?
2. When the house of Israel asked Ezekiel what he was doing, what did God tell him to say according to verse 10? Who do you think “the prince of Jerusalem” is?
3. In the second sign God gave Ezekiel in verse 17, he was told, “eat your bread with trembling and drink your water with quivering and anxiety”. What would this sign indicate to the people of Judah?

Chapter 13

4. According to verse two, on what basis or by whose authority were these prophets speaking?
5. What was God’s attitude toward those prophets who claimed to speak for Him when in fact He hadn’t given them a vision? Do you think this aroused God’s righteous anger?
6. Verses 17 through 23 reveal the treachery of the false prophetesses. According to verse 19 what motivated them to commit such atrocities?

Chapter 14

7. Who came and sat down in front of Ezekiel in verse one? Are these leaders of God’s people sincerely trying to do the Lord’s will?
8. What statement in verse 4 and in verse 7 indicates that when we stray from God and set up idols in our hearts, that we hurt Him and we sin against Him?
9. In verses 12 through 14 God mentions three very faithful men. Who were they what lesson was God trying to teach His unfaithful people?

Chapter 15

10. God asked Ezekiel how the wood of a vine was better than the wood of a branch on a tree. What was God expecting Israel to give Him but they never did?
11. What sin did God charge Israel with according to verse eight for which He would make the land desolate?
