

# Lesson Eight

Ezekiel Chapters 29, 30, 31, 32

## Chapter 29

1. How does the Lord describe Pharaoh in verse three? What was king Pharaoh saying about himself and what sinful attitude did this represent?
2. How long would the land of Egypt remain desolate according to verse 12?
3. Verses 19 and 20 mention that God gave the land of Egypt to Nebuchadnezzar. What specific reason is listed for this and who was Nebuchadnezzar "working for" according to verse 20?

## Chapter 30

4. Verse three mentions that "the day of the Lord" is near. What do you think this phrase refers to? And why do you think it is called a "day of clouds"?
5. How does God describe the allies of Nebuchadnezzar who came into Egypt to destroy it in verse 11?
6. In verses 23 through 25, God seems to be making a contrast between Nebuchadnezzar and Pharaoh. What did God do for Nebuchadnezzar and what did He do to Pharaoh?

## Chapter 31

7. What figure does God use in verses 2 through 18 to describe the magnificence and power of Pharaoh, king of Egypt?
8. What phrase in verse 11 indicates that God's judges and punishes people according to their sinfulness?

## Chapter 32

9. What did the king of Egypt compare himself to according to verses one and two? What did God say Pharaoh was really like in verse two?
10. What six powerful nations are mentioned in verses 22 through 30 as being cast down into Sheol [the realm of the dead]?
