8. Chapter 12 is a pivotal point in the gospel of John. Read 12:27-36:
  - a) In verse 28, what was Jesus asking the Father to do by saying, “glorify your name”?
  - b) Explain the Father’s response: “I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again”.
9. How did Jesus say he had glorified God on earth? (17:4)
10. Compare 17:5 with the Prologue. What is confirmed here?
11. What did Jesus give to the believers, and why? (17:22-23)
12. What did Jesus want believers to ultimately see? (17:24)
