e) How is this related to the Passover, if at all?

3. a) What is another name for this feast? (7:2; research its significance.)  
  
b) What question arises, more than once? (7:26,41,etc)  
  
c) What does Jesus exclaim on the last day of the feast? What does water have to do with this feast, if anything?  
  
d) What else does Jesus proclaim about himself, and what might it have to do with this feast? (8:12)  
  
e) What miracle takes place in chapter 9, and what is its significance? (v1-7;35-41)

#### *The Feast of Dedication*

4. a) By what other names is this feast known? (10:22)  
  
b) What is the history of this feast?  
  
c) Who hears the voice of Jesus? (v27,1-6)  
  
d) What did Jesus proclaim that he was doing? (v25,32,37,38)
